

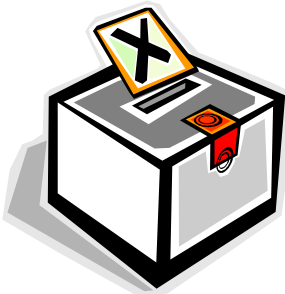

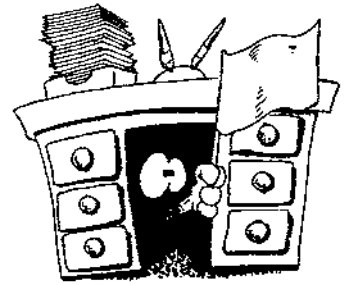

Porsche 911 Speedster to debut at Paris Motor Show

Paying homage to the first Porsche model to bear the Speedster name -- the 356 Speedster -- Porsche has announced that a new 911 Speedster will make its debut at the Paris Motor Show in early October. Significantly different from other members of the 911 family, this two-seat roadster features a 2.36" (60 millimeter) lower, more raked windscreen and the characteristic speedster double-bubble hardcover for the manual soft top. Helping to define the striking profile of the new 2011 911 Speedster, the 1.73" (44 millimeter) wide-body from

the AWD 911 models makes the rear-wheel-drive only Speedster stand out even more. The production run of this special car will be limited to 356 units worldwide, with approximately 100 heading to the U.S.

The 2.0-liter TDI mill is putting out 140 hp and 236 lb.-ft. of torque and with a fire extinguisher mounted on the diamond-plate floor boards, we think we might have found the perfect track-day accomplice to join that GT3 RS we've been building in our dreams.

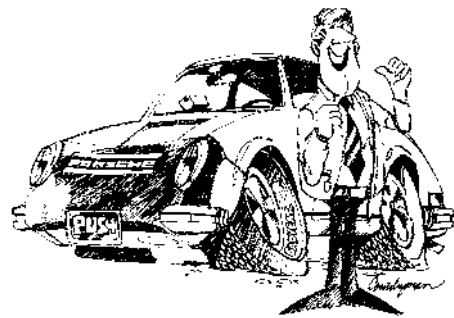

Ken's Ramblings....

Summer is winding down and the weather is delightful with cool nights, bright days, etc, etc. A great time to get out and explore the back roads of KY in a Porsche. I applaud the leadership that folks have assumed to encourage weekend drives.

I just finished a 1963 356 engine. It was originally a full race 356 engine with lots of 'exotic' internals. Beautiful....except it was useless in a street car. It has a Scat crank and Carrillo rods. We reused the crank and rods since they were compatible with the street car intent and almost too pretty to hide inside an engine. The 'race' cam had been reground on a R200.5 wide lobe core, unfortunately the tips were already worn, as were the cam followers, and the rocker arm tips were pitted. Replaced the cam with a mild grind on another R200.5 core. Tim Bererdelli reworked the cam, lifters and the rocker arm tips. The cylinder heads were also highly modified with custom Datsun valves and extensive porting. The intake manifolds were modified to match the heads, effectively ruining the heads and manifolds for street use. We replaced the 009 distributor (questionable advance) with a 022. The Solex 40P11 carbs were altered with oversize venturis and jets (easy enough to replace them with a more suitable set for street use). It had a Ron LaDow (Precision Matters) full flow oil pump. The piston/cylinder set were high compression Shastas. The engine tin was from a 912 and anything but pretty. They even had pop rivets holding it together...The engine was completely disassembled and rebuilt to street specs and the 'hot rod' parts packed with a future on e-bay.

Jim Perrin found another Denzel car and engine. Jim and Brenda brought the engine down a couple of weeks ago and with Andy's help we took it apart to clean it up and see if it was savable. It is :-). These rare engines are fun and a challenge to restore...

Word is that PCA is looking at West Baden as the site for a future Parade.

Time to consider officers for The Kentucky Region for next year. Personally I like the team for 2010 and encourage retaining them for 2011.

On a sad note, the 21 September CJ has the obituary for Nelson Rath, age 64. Nelson was a very active member of The Kentucky Region PCA and very involved in the old Porsche Derby. Nelson owned a beautiful red 356 Carrera 2 Cabriolet. One Porsche Derby it was raining heavily on concours morning and he called me to assure that I was going to bring my 356C out in the rain. I assured him that I was, he told me that he would also bring the Carrera Cab and 'get it wet' if I would get my 356C 'wet'. Nelson had a great sense of humor and was a good friend. Later he sold the 356 and got involved with Jaguars. Nelson is survived by his wife Nancy of 42 years and two sons, Mark Allen (Jessica) and David Clifton (Heather) and granddaughter.

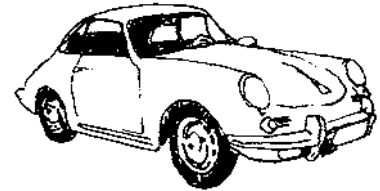
